

Cookie Policy

Effective date: May 27th, 2024

When you visit Prometic Bioproduction Inc. (“**Prometic**”, “**we**”, or “**us**”)’s website (the “**Website**”), when you contact us through social media or by email, or when you apply for a job with us, Prometic and the third parties we authorize may use cookies to collect information about you. This Cookie Policy (the “**Policy**”) explains how Prometic and third parties we authorize use cookies when you interact with our Website.

This Policy should be read in conjunction with our [Privacy Policy](#), which describes how Prometic collects, uses and discloses personal information collected through the Website, as well as the rights of visitors of the Website regarding their personal information.

1. What are Cookies?

Cookies are small pieces of data (text files) that are saved on your computer, mobile phone, or any other device you used to access the Internet when you visit our Website so that information, such as your language preferences, can be saved between visits.

Cookies may be temporary (“session cookies”) if they are only active during your visit to our Website and are removed when you close your browser. Cookies may also be permanent (“persistent cookies”) if they remain on your device permanently after you leave our Website, and are removed only when you manually delete them or when your browser deletes them after a certain time.

The cookies we set are referred to as first-party cookies. We also use third-party cookies, which are cookies set by a domain other than those set by the Website you have visited.

2. What Types of Cookies are used on our Website?

As further described in our cookie management tool, which you may access by visiting our Website homepage, our Website uses the following types of cookies:

Strictly Necessary Cookies

These cookies are necessary for the Website’ functioning and security and cannot be disabled in our systems. They are typically only set in response to actions you take that amount to a service request, such as setting your privacy preferences, logging on, or filling out forms. You cannot set your browser to block or alert you about these cookies, since their deactivation would prevent parts of the Website from properly functioning.

Preference Cookies

These cookies are used to recognize and remember your preferences. For example, preference cookies may use information, such as your language preferences, to ensure that you arrive at a version of our Website that will provide you with a continuous experience.

Marketing Cookies

These cookies are used to display ads that are relevant to you on our Website and elsewhere. If you disable or delete these cookies, or if you opt-out of online targeted advertising, you may see more generic ads.
